DECLARATION OF DISASTER


WHEREAS, the County of Brazoria on the 9th day of May, 2019, is forecast to experience widespread and severe damage, injury, or loss of property resulting from the recent flooding of the Brazos River in Rosharon and several other communities along the Brazos River, and

WHEREAS, the Brazoria County Judge has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property, roads, and parks,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF BRAZORIA COUNTY

1. That a local state of disaster is hereby declared for Brazoria County pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. Pursuant to §418.108(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners Court of Brazoria County.
3. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
4. Pursuant to §418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the county emergency management plan.
5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
