EXTENSION OF DISASTER DECLARATION

WHEREAS, on the 9th Day of May, 2019, the Brazoria County Judge issued a proclamation declaring a state of disaster for Brazoria County resulting from widespread severe damage and loss of property from recent flooding of the Brazos River in Rosharon and several other communities along the Brazos River; and

WHEREAS, the conditions necessitating the declaration of a state of disaster continue to exist; and,

WHEREAS, at least 100 homes are expected to be damaged or affected by flood; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code provides that a local state of disaster may not be continued for a period in excess of seven days without consent of the governing body of a political subdivision;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT of Brazoria County:

1. That the state of disaster proclaimed for Brazoria County by the County Judge on the 9th day of May, 2019 shall continue until terminated by order of the COMMISSIONERS COURT.
2. This order is passed as an emergency measure and shall become effective on the 14th day of May, 2019.
