INVITATION TO BIDDERS

Brazoria County Community Development (hereinafter called CD Dept) will receive bids for the repair of a septic system which is federally funded by HUD #B-18-UC-48-0005, until 2:00 p.m. on September 11, 2019 at the Community Development Dept, 1524 E. Mulberry, Suite 162, Angleton, TX 77515.

Quotes are invited for the items and quantities of work as follows:

Repair sanitary septic system at the follow location:
6818 Amy Lane, Rosharon, Texas

Bids are to be returned to Brazoria County Community Development Dept by either email, mail, or in person. Scope of work will consist of and includes the submission of:

1. Brazoria County welcomes, encourages, and supports responses and active participation from qualified firms owned by minorities and/or women.
2. Complete bid with **all forms completed and signed, and all required documents returned.**
3. Contractor must obtain all required septic permits required through the Brazoria County Environmental Health Dept or TCEQ.
4. Section 3 of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968, as amended, the regulations set forth in 24 CFR Part 135, and all applicable rules and orders.
5. Contractor's bid must include turn key product which may include, but is not limited to, any supplemental inspections for warranty, grading of the property disturbed, and fill dirt around the septic tanks.
6. Attention is called that **this is a HUD funded project.** Davis-Bacon wage rates will apply and certified payrolls are required. Employees will also be interviewed.
7. **Contractor must provide a list of all subcontractors to be used on this project.** The amount of the contract between the sub and the prime must be noted. Failure to supply this list may result in non-compliance, and possible disqualification of the bid.

Contractor shall furnish labor, equipment, permits, final grading, and subcontractors to complete the installation of the septic system.

In addition, the successful bidder must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of race, color, religion, sex, age, handicap, or national origin.

CD Dept reserves the right to reject any or all bids or to waive any informality in the bidding. Bids may be held by the CD Dept for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigating the bidder's qualifications prior to the contract award.

All contractors/subcontractors that are debarred, suspended, or otherwise excluded from, or ineligible for participation on federally funded programs, may not undertake any activity in full or in part under any of these projects.
